Especially in the winter season, you can eat delicious blowfish. Aichi boasts the largest catch of "natural tiger blowfish" in Japan.

This area is also known for octopus. In Japanese, an octopus is called "TAKO" and a blowfish is called "FUGU". Similar to the pronunciation of TAKO is the word "takou", which

means a lot of happiness. And similar to FUGU's pronunciation is the word "fuku", which means fortune.

Therefore, in Japan, these two seafood items are often served at celebration dinners.
