


Go To Campaign

The Japanese government has been running "Go To Campaign" since July 22, 2020. The campaign aims to stimulate the demand for domestic tourism which has fallen as a result of the spread of the coronavirus.

Actually there are 4 types of Go To campaigns: Go To Travel Campaign, Go To Eat Campaign, Go To Event Campaign and Go To Shop Campaign.

Among them, the "Go To Travel Campaign" is the most popular one. Its goal is to subsidize up to 50% of personal travel expenses, including accommodations and transportation.



35% of the total costs and another 15 % is covered by regional coupons. The coupons can be used at travel destinations for shopping, food, and activities.

All residents in Japan are eligible for this campaign. However, tourists from overseas visiting Japan are not eligible. Unfortunately, due to the recent nationwide surge of Covid-19, certain regions where a high number of cases are reported, such as Hokkaido, Osaka are excluded from the campaign for a time being.

can enjoy locally brewed beer and hot springs surrounded by beautifully colored flowers. The large greenhouses that display begonias from around the world is one of the attractions that should not be missed.

Although you can enjoy the park by viewing seasonal flowers year around, the best season to visit here is definitely winter.

During the winter season(24OCT20~

31MAY21), millions of LED lights illuminate



the flower park. With the most famous illumination display of "tunnel of lights" (see the picture), Nabana no Sato offers one of the most fascinating and biggest illumination event in Japan.
