The Olympic Flame Will Reach Tokyo Soon

Based on the concept of "Hope Lights Our Way", the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Torch Relay is being held across all 47 prefectures of Japan for a period 121 days. It started its journey on 25 March from Fukushima Prefecture. The total number of the Torch Relay participants is expected to be about 10,000.

There are only 4 prefectures left to reach the final destination, Olympic Stadium (New National Stadium Japan).

**The remaining Relay schedule is: 1-3 July in Chiba, 4-5 July in Ibaraki, 6-8 July in Saitama, 9-23 July in Tokyo*

We are hoping that the Torch Relay, and the Olympic and Paralympic Games will be organized safely with a great success even under the COVID-19 pandemic environment.

"Umi-biraki (Beach opening)" is an event that marks the beginning of the swimming season. The season runs from July 1st through the end of August, depending on the location and its temperature. Beach shops are open and beach equipment is available for various activities on the beaches.

On the first day of "umi-biraki", a Shinto ceremony is held to wish for a safe and prosperous season.

However, in order to avoid the spreading of the Novel Coronavirus, this year's ceremony and event might get cancelled or postponed. Some beaches may even be closed for the entire season. You need to check the latest information before you plan to go to the beach.





RECOMMENDED SIGHT SEEING SPOT and NEAREST AIRPORT

Kenroku-en(Kanazawa city, Ishikawa Prefecture)

Kenroku-en is an old private garden that is listed as one of the Three Great Gardens of Japan along with Kairaku-en (Mito city, Ibaraki prefecture) and Korakuen (Okayama city, Okayama prefecture).

During the Edo period (1603-1868AD), Kenroku-en was founded, and extended over generations by the feudal lords of **Kaga domain*, as a typical **Daimyo* garden.

Located in the center of Kanazawa city, it has been appreciated by both citizens and tourists from all over the world as a landscape garden that shows a different flavor in each season.
