Karato Market (Shimonoseki City, Yamaguchi Prefecture)

Karato Market is one of the most popular fish markets in Japan. It is located on the western edge of Japan's main island, Honshu, Karato market is filled with spirit and energy from the early morning to the early evening.

Every weekend and on national holidays, a festive fish market event called "Ikiikibakangai (lively-bakangai) is held. A series of seafood stalls are lined up where you can buy and eat a variety of

seasonal fish, including many different species of blowfish, sushi, etc. at a reasonable price.

Affectionately known as the "Local Kitchen" by the local residents, Karato market is a great place for fish lovers to shop around while having fun talking with the friendly shop staff.

When the weather is nice, it is recommended to eat outside where there is a stunning view of Kanmon Straits that separates Honshu and Kyushu islands.
