Japanese officials will ease border restrictions from June 1. Authorities will divide countries and regions according to three categories depending on COVID-19 activity, with the following restrictions for international arrivals.

Classification	Vaccination certificate	On-arrival Test	Quarantine period and other measures after entry into Japan
Red	No	Required	3-day quarantine at a specific facility designated by the chief of the quarantine station (+negative test result (PCR test) at the facility)
	Yes	Required	3-day home quarantine + negative result of a voluntary test
Yellow	No	Required	or 7-day home quarantine without test
	Yes	Not required	
Blue	No	Not required	Home quarantine and other measures are not required
	Yes	Not required

Rainy season in Japan

There is a long rainy season in Japan. It usually begins in early June and ends in July. We call this early summer rainy season “Tsuyu” in Japanese.

Tsuyu is literally translated as plum rain due to the fact that the rainy season starts around the time plums begin to ripen.

On rainy days in Japan, it is a tradition for children to make a doll out of tissue paper and hang it from the roof eaves to bring good weather. This doll is called “Teru-Teru-bozu”, which means sunshine doll.

Kurobe Canyon

The Kurobe Gorge in Toyama is known as one of the deepest gorges in Japan. It is a very popular and attracts a lot of visitors.

The main attraction of the gorge is the Kurobe Gorge Railway, a sightseeing train originally built to aid the construction of the Kurobe Dam.

Today the small trains operate along a winding, 20 kilometer stretch. The exciting 80 minutes journey leads across more than 20 bridges and through over 40 tunnels, and offers visitors panoramic views of the gorge below.

The train operates between the Unazuki area and the Keyakidaira area. The operating periods is from mid-April to November but the exact dates depend on the snow depth.
