#### New Year's Greeting Card - Nengajo-

Have you sent Christmas cards to your families and friends? In Japan, we have a tradition of sending a New Year's greeting card, called 'Nengajo' (年賀状), to people whom you want to express gratitude for the year gone by, and also to renew good relationships with others for the new year.



It also serves the purpose of wishing remote families and friends to be well.

The messages are commonly written on postcards which we call 'hagaki' (はがき). So the postcard greeting cards can also be called nenga-hagaki (年賀はがき). 'Nenga' (年賀) means New Year's greeting. These are usually designed with symbols of good luck, or the animal of the year (one of the 12 animals in the Chinese astrological calendar). Many people include their family photos to show how they are.

Over the past few years, as you would expect, many people are now sending their New Year's greetings using online chat or e-mails because it is much easier than sending physical cards. However, there are still quite a few people who follow the tradition of actually mailing New Year's cards to keep in touch with people who they have not seen for a while.

### **Tokyo Daijingu**

Tokyo Daijingu is one of the five major shinto-shrines in Tokyo, and it is famous for being a shrine for a good marriage. Historically, a wedding ceremony was normally held at one's own home. But during the Meiji-era (1868-1912), a Japanese wedding was held at Tokyo Daijingu for the first time for members of the public. This was a breakthrough in the Japanese wedding tradition.

Around the shrine, there are many interesting sightseeing spots and great restaurants. There is much to enjoy in the area after visiting Tokyo Daijingu.
