April marks a fresh start with cherry blossoms

The school year in Japan starts in April. We see many new students in brand new uniforms in the streets. This is also the time when cherry blossoms are in full bloom.

Since many schools have cherry trees growing on their ground during this season, this beautiful scenery makes Japanese people nostalgic about their own fresh start every school year.

Some educational institutions have tried to move the beginning of the school year to September in order to align with schools and universities in other countries. But because Spring is so closely associated with new beginnings in Japan, the school year continues to start in April.

Takayama Festival (Matsuri) in Gifu prefecture

The Takayama Festival is one of Japan's three most beautiful festivals, along with Kyoto's Gion Festival and Saitama's Chichibu Night Festival. The Takayama Festival is held twice a year in Spring and Autumn in the old town of Takayama.

The Spring Takayama Festival is the annual festival of the Hie Shrine. It is held on April 14th and 15th every year in the southern half of Takayama's old town. The spectators especially enjoy both the festival activities and the cherry blossoms.

The Autumn Festival is held October 9th and 10th. It is the annual festival of the Hachiman Shrine and takes place in the northern half of the old town.

The Festival is famous for its procession of elaborately decorated floats. Some of the floats are topped with puppets called Karakuri dolls. These are traditional Japanese mechanical puppets. The festival begins in the morning and lasts until the evening. In the morning, these floats are paraded from the shrine. In the afternoon, the puppets on the floats perform a traditional dance. In the evening, floats are led through the streets accompanied by traditional music played by flutes and stringed instruments, together with swinging lanterns on each float. The Takayama Festival is a very popular event. Several hundred thousand people from all over Japan and the world attend the Festival every year.
