#### Art in the Rice Fields

These days, there is a new challenge on Japanese rice fields called 'rice field art'. Artists turn rice fields into big canvases and make pictures by using many different kinds of rice plants in the fields. It all started in Inakadate Village in



Aomori Prefecuture in 1993, the birthplace of rice fields art. The artist drew a huge picture with colorful rice ears on the rice field as if it were a canvas. It started with 3 colors, but as the techniques improved, the variety of colors increased to 7 colors today. The increase in colors made it easier for artists to design more detailed pictures.

The harvest season for rice is September to October but the best season for this type of art is July to August.

#### **Motonosumi Shrine**

Motonosumi Shrine, located in Yamaguchi prefecture, was selected by CNN Travel as one of the "31 Most Beautiful Places in Japan." It was constructed over a decade beginning in 1987, and its 123 torii gates beautifully frame the hill toward the Sea of Japan. A SAISEN (money offered to gods) box is placed between the horizontal beams at the top of the tallest torii gate. It is said that the wishes will be granted if you can successfully throw coins into the saisen box.
